The People's Coalition of Cayo **Presents: Understanding The Law**

The People's Coalition of Cayo (PCC) through this medium wants you to know the law. This week's law is: **NOISE ABATEMENT.**

This law refers to unreasonable noise emissions from vehicles, equipment, and premises. The law provides for specific types of intervention from the Public, Environment Department and the Police.

In as far as <u>unreasonable</u> (More than 43 decibels) noise pollution from equipment (machinery, sound systems such as DJ's music boxes, personal music players, loud shouting and

screaming, toys that make sounds, etc), is an offence and against the

Prosecution happens when any three or more people lodge a complaint to authorities, which can be oral or in writing, that they are being affected by the unreasonable noise in this instance.

A Police Officer or any authorized person can ask the proprietor of the house, restaurant, bar, to keep the unreasonable noise to the minimum or the authorized person can ask that the source of the pollution be removed entirely.

From the day the premises is warned to install the necessary conditions to have their function without affecting other people

negatively, the premises has one week to commit to this regulation or licenses to such functions will be revoked.

This offence carries a penalty of one thousand dollars or more or imprisonment for not less than three months.

In as far as unreasonable noise pollution for vehicles, authorized personnel from the Police or the Environment department can measure the noise emitted from the vehicle and if the vehicle is not within the limits of acceptance of the law, the proprietor has six weeks after the offence has been read to him to get the noise under control.

Failure to comply with this law and condition can lead to a fine of no less than ten thousand dollars or imprisonment of no less than two years or both fine and impris-

onment.

The People's Coalition of Cayo wants to empower every citizen with the understanding of the laws of Belize. We hope that we can serve you well and help you help our communities develop under the guidance of the law.



Justice Denys Barrow Returns To Private Practice Effective February 28, 2011

By letter dated 24th January 2011 I conveyed to His Excellency the Governor General my decision to return to private practice as an attorney at law. The resignation is to take effect from 28th February.

The decision stems from the refusal of the Government of St Lucia to pay pension benefits due to me upon my retirement, two years ago, as a Court of Appeal Judge in the Eastern Caribbean.

Matters reached the point where I was forced to file a claim on 14th January 2011 against the Government of St Lucia which has been simply ignoring the claim, latterly refusing to even acknowledge receipt of letters of inquiry.

Having returned at the end of 2008 to Belize and to private practice, I later decided I could afford to leave private practice and become a judge in Belize because I treated the expected pension benefits as part of my financial resources. That expectation having been removed, I must now adjust. Hence, my decision to return to practice.

I express my gratitude to

the Government of Belize for the honour conferred on me by the appointment.

I am especially grateful for the confidence and support members of the public, on both sides of the political divide, expressed on my appointment and during my tenure.

It took courage for the Prime Minister, Hon. Dean Barrow, to appoint his brother to the judiciary and no less courage for the Leader of the Opposition, Hon. John Briceno, to support that appointment. I salute them.

I am confident that the Court of Appeal under its new President, the Honourable Manuel Sosa, with the support of its new member, the Honourable Sir Brian Alleyne, and its newly re-appointed member, the Honourable Dennis Morrison, will continue to provide satisfaction to the nation in delivering justice.



Members of the BBA are involved in the production of a product with a controlled price, hence we are asking the government that we be allowed to benefit from lower butane prices, something that BNE says they can offer to the Belizean people. Bing's Supermarket Robbed AGAIN

SAN IGNACIO, Cayo, Friday, **January 28, 2011:**

San Ignacio Police are presently questioning several suspects in the latest robbery at Bing's Supermarket located at the corner of Bishop Martin and Hibiscus Streets in Santa Elena, Cayo.



The Chinese proprietor of the store, Qing Jei Zhu, 52, reported to police that at around 8:30 am on Monday, January 24, he was seated behind the counter in his store when an unmasked brown skin male person, about 5 1/2 feet in height, wearing a yellow and white striped shirt and long blue pants, walked in and after fidgeting with some merchandise on the counter, the man moved towards the rum section located behind the counter. Zhu reportedly got up to serve him and while turned with his back towards to man pointing out the kind of rum the man wanted, the man reportedly move behind him, placed a small black gun to his head and pulled out the license 9mm Compact Luger pistol that Zhu had tucked in the waist band of his pants. The gun was fitted with a magazine containing 8 bullets. Zhu informed that it was a new gun which he purchased in Belize City, less than three months ago, for \$2,500. It bears serial number A480315.



The man then demanded, and was given, all the money from inside the drawer which, since it was early in the morning, amounted to about \$200.

In the process of the investigation police have detained several persons for questioning and identification which is facilitated by the fact that the robber did not wear a mask.

This is the third time that Bing's Supermarket has been robbed. The last incident occurred ten months

ago, on March 17, 2010 when, at around 8:40 pm, two masked gunmen entered the store and made off with over seven hundred dollars in cash.

The other incident occurred at around 1:30 pm on May 13, 2009 when two armed masked men entered the store and held up Zhu's 18 year old son, Zhu Bing Chi, making off with over seven hundred dollars in cash and about five hundred dollar in telephone cards.

Mexico Enacts New Asylum Law



MEXICO CITY, January 26, 2011 (EFE):

Mexican President Felipe Calderon signed into law on Wednesday, January 26, a measure aimed at bringing Mexico's handling of refugee and political asylum claims into line with international agreements.

The law was drafted "taking into account the model legislation of the (office of the) United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees," Calderon said during the signing ceremony in Mexico

Mexico also sought input from domestic and international organizations.

From now on, Mexico will consider applications for refugee status from any person who cites a fear of being "persecuted for his race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social

group or political opinions," the president said.

Gender persecution will also be considered legitimate grounds for an asylum claim, he said

Mexico likewise pledges not to send any asylum seeker or refugee to a country where that person's life, liberty or safety would be at risk, Calderon said.

Another provisions of the law protects legitimate refugees and asylum seekers from being prosecuted for illegally entering the country, and officially recognized refugees will have a right to work as well as access to health care and education.

Calderon pointed out that Mexico gave asylum to people fleeing the Spanish Civil War, World War II, Latin American military regimes, civil conflicts in Central America and, most recently, survivors of the January 2010 earthquake in Haiti.
